41st ANNIVERSARY VISIT OF HIS I-VINE MAJESTY EMPEROR HAILE SELLASSIE I THE FIRST.

April 21st 2007 marks the 41st anniversary visit to Jamaica by His Imperial Majesty Emperor Haile Sellassie I the First, King of Kings, Lord of Lords, Conquering lion of Judah. This is an historic and symbolic occasion for both the Rastafari nation and Jamaica at large. It should not go unnoticed.

The official state visit of His Imperial Majesty Emperor Haile Sellassie I the First to Jamaica is unparalleled and unprecedented in the islands history. The first and only King to visit the island stated in his address to parliament “ Upon arrival in Jamaica I have seen more than I have expected. I have seen the progress of the people and I have seen their determination to march forward in unity towards greater progress. I have also witnessed personally, the extent of the feeling of the Jamaican people for the Ethiopian people”.

The Ancient Order of the Nyahbinghi is organizing a celebration to mark this historical occasion from April 20-23, 2007. The agenda will start with a cultural concert on Friday the 20th at Mico Teachers College auditorium starting at 3.00 p.m.. This will be a staged event that will highlight the consciousness and the talents of a variety of our cultural performers including Reggae, Poetry, Dancing and more.

On Saturday the 21st our celebration will continue at the National Heroes Park which is in close proximity to the Mico College. There will be presentations and testimonies from representatives of the various mansions like the Twelve Tribes of Israel (T.T.I.), Ethiopia Black International Congress (E.A.B.I.C.), Ethiopian Judah Coptic Church, School of Vision, Ethiopian Orthodox Church, including speakers from the U.W.I. among others, after which there will be Nyahbinghi drumming and chanting throughout the night.

On Sunday the 22nd there will be testimonies from our Ancients who were there at the Kings arrival. Also there will be showing of films pertaining to the visit and the Coronation of His Majesty among others, after which there will be more drumming and chanting throughout the night, giving praises to the King of all Kings.

Monday the 23rd will see an evening with discussions on “Repatriation and the Ethiopian Millennium”...Also “The Unification of the Rastafari Movement for the Purpose of Repatriation”,(U.R.M.P.R.). Drumming and chanting will be the order of the night.

There will be displays of art and craft, books, African clothing etc. these will also be on sale. We are asking all who are interested in renting a stall for the purpose of the display and sale of any of these items to please call Ras Sasse at (876) 379- 6084 for more information.
